

Nature Play Fall 2019

The Community Services Division would like to welcome participants to join our 2019 Fall Nature Play program. Each week, we will meet at the Lt. Colonel Clifton Centre before heading outdoors to take part in nature themed activities along the Chinook Parkway.

This 4 week program is open for children in Grades 1-5 and runs on Saturday mornings from 10am-12pm. The program will begin on September 21st and run until October 12th. Each week participants will meet and return to:

- Lt. Colonel Clifton Centre (LCCC) – Lower Lounge - 350 6th Ave NE

Please ensure that your child comes equipped with appropriate clothing for all weather conditions as we will be outdoors with little access to shelter most of the time. As it is the fall, it may get cold or wet and children may get dirty with activities.

Clothing Recommendations: running shoes or rain boots, coat (can be waterproof), hat, gloves and a water bottle
