Property Owners

This area lists the names of all owners associated with the property.

Legal Land Description

This area contains data/legal descriptions that are used by the Assessment Department.

2022 Property Assessment

This area contains the current assessed value, taxable value and additional information regarding your property.

School Support Allocation

Each year when the City collects property taxes from you, a portion of those taxes are collected on behalf of the Public/Seperate School Divisions. These funds, when collected from each property, are disbursed to the School Divisions in the proportion indicated in this box.

You can change the proportions associated with your property up to 30 days following the date Assessment Notices are mailed out each year.

History of the Property's Assessed Value

This area contains the Assessed Value of the property this year and the previous four (4) years.

How to File an Appeal

Before you file, we encourage you to speak with a member of our Assessment Team. We can frequently help you resolve issues without the need for a formal Appeals process.

If you choose to Appeal, you must fill out **Form C**, which is available at City Hall or online at: swiftcurrent.ca/assessment

Your completed **Form C** must be provided to the Secretary for the Board of Revision along with an **Appeal Fee of \$25.00**.
