



Kinetic Park Campground COVID-19 Policies

Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, additional rules and regulations are in place for the 2020 camping season to ensure safety of all campers and facility staff. Guidelines are in accordance with the Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan and are subject to change as phases are implemented, changed or put on hold.

- The Kinetic Park Campground will be open as of June 1st on a per-booking basis. All bookings must be made in advance by calling 306-778-1621 or online at www.swiftcurrent.ca/play. Drop-in camping will not be permitted.
- Payment must be made in advance for all bookings. Payment can be made with a credit card over the phone or during the online booking process.
- Seven business days' notice is required for all cancellations.
- Currently, operators of regional parks are permitted to continue accepting and fulfilling reservations from out of province residents. Similarly, Kinetic Park will continue to permit out of province campers to book a campsite in the park.
- Non-essential travel from out of province is strongly discouraged. Out of province users are asked to minimize any non-essential travel within the park.
- Campers are reminded to follow physical distancing protocols, keeping at least two metres distance between yourself and others.
- Campers are encouraged to use the washroom/shower facilities located in their trailer or recreational vehicles, avoiding public bathrooms.
- Washroom access will be limited to one household at a time. Regular cleaning protocols will be in place for the washrooms.
- If you feel unwell, have been exposed to a positive case of COVID-19, have travelled out of the country in the last 14 days, are being tested or have tested positive for COVID-19, please do not enter the campgrounds. Should a cancellation be required for these reasons, 24 hours notice must be provided for a full refund.
- The size of public and private gatherings must not exceed 30 people.
- Prior to travelling, please check the current public health orders to ensure there are no travel restrictions for the area. Travel restrictions are subject to change and must continue to be followed.
